NOTES:

- ***** No schooling over the jumps prior to the start of classes *****
- **REGULAR JUMPER CLASSES**
 - One round per horse/rider combination allowed, with the exception of "no judge rounds".
 - Classes will be competitive and riders will receive ribbons.
 - Classes scored under Table II.1.
- **SCHOOLING JUMPER CLASSES**
 - Schooling jumper classes scored and a blue ribbon for clean rounds are awarded for those jumping the prescribed course.
 - Multiple paid rounds at any fence heights are allowed.
 - Outside assistance is allowed.
 - It is not required to jump the prescribed course and no entry will be eliminated except in the instance of a safety concern for horse or rider. However, there is a maximum time allowed for any round of 3.0 minutes.
